MINUTES OF THE MEETING

IIT Palakkad and IIT Madras – TIH Meeting:

- 1. To take equity from startups which would enable to achieve the long-term revenue for the hub as mentioned by the TIH board.
- 2. The HI and TIH can apply for CSR and implement it by the hub.
- 3. Advised to have regular meetings with the IIT Director and PD, thereby achieving the NMICPS mission's goals.
- 4. HI and TIH should work collaboratively for external projects and can have a tripartite agreement.
- 5. TIH can approach funds through the brand of IIT Palakkad.
- 6. To ensure transparency, TIH must have a Technical Evaluation Committee to evaluate all the proposals received. The evaluation committee must include industry-oriented people.
- 7. The auditor for the TIH must be independent of the HI.
- 8. Strictly avoid favours made by academics and Hub management employees.
- 9. HI can collaborate with IIT Palakkad for public relations activities.
- 10. TIH can conduct Skill Development Programs (SDP) in collaboration with the HI and mention the HI's name in certificates, if necessary. The SDP cannot be expensive.
- 11. HUBs can be subject to CAG audit as the Government of India funds the hub.
