Prof. Mayank Vatsa is a Professor of Computer Science and Dean (R & D) at IIT Jodhpur, India and a Swarnajayanti Fellow. Earlier, he was a Professor at IIIT-Delhi. He received his Masters and PhD in Computer Science from the Lane Department of Computer Science and Electrical Engineering at West Virginia University. He has over 350 publications in refereed journals, book chapters, and conferences and has received several best paper/poster awards. He is also Fellow of IEEE, IAPR and AAIA.

Prof. Vatsa was a member of the Indian Biometrics Standards Committee for e-gov applications. He also served as a member of the UIDAI's Biomtrics Standard Subcommittee (face, fingerprint, and iris standards). He is also a member of Golden Key International, Phi Kappa Phi, Tau Beta Pi, Sigma Xi, Upsilon Pi Epsilon, and Eta Kappa Nu honor societies. He also served as Vice President (Publications) for IEEE Biometrics Council and an Area Editor of Information Fusion (Elsevier).

Prof. Vatsa's current areas of interest are biometrics, computer vision, image processing, machine learning, deep learning, image forensics, and information fusion.
