

Telediagnostic technologies and quality medical care to underprivileged women and children living in remote areas

TIFAC, has conceptualized a scalable pilot demonstration telemedicine project (PLUG and PLAY model) to provide quality medical care to under privileged women and children living in remote areas at affordable costs. The pioneering project aims to demonstrate efficacy of applying cutting edge Tele diagnostic technologies in reaching out to people living in such areas with quality medical care. Through this Technological outreach mechanism, people living in such areas would have access to medical care of such quality which hitherto they were unable to get. The project is being implemented in partnership with IITM Pravartak Technologies Foundation in collaboration of C-DAC Mohali and Health Cube India Private Limited.
